

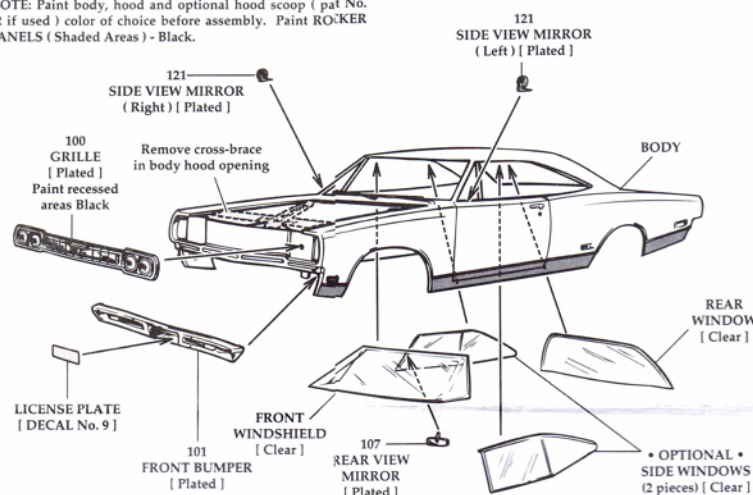

NOTE: Paint body, hood and optional hood scoop ( pat No. 92 if used ) color of choice before assembly. Paint ROCKER PANELS ( Shaded Areas ) - Black.

- LICENSE PLATE [ DECAL No. 9 ]**: The license plate, shown as a separate piece to be attached to the front of the car.
- \* OPTIONAL \* SIDE WINDOWS ( 2 pieces ) [ Clear ]**: Two optional side windows, shown as separate pieces to be attached to the sides of the car.

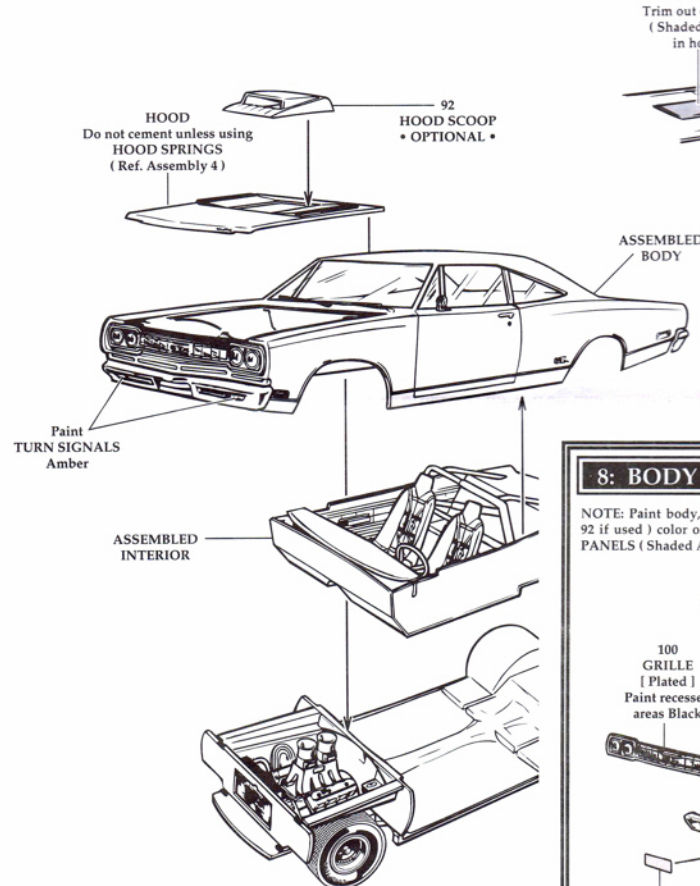

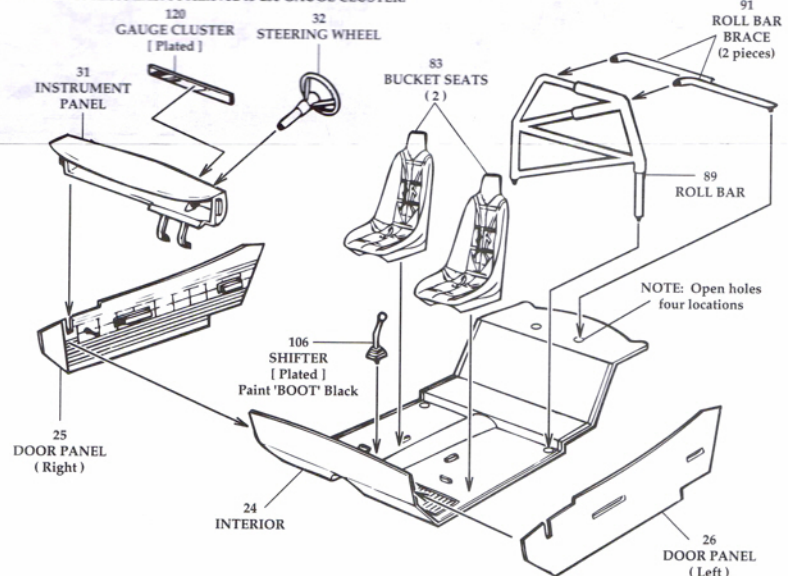
## 2: ENGINE / FINAL ASSEMBLY

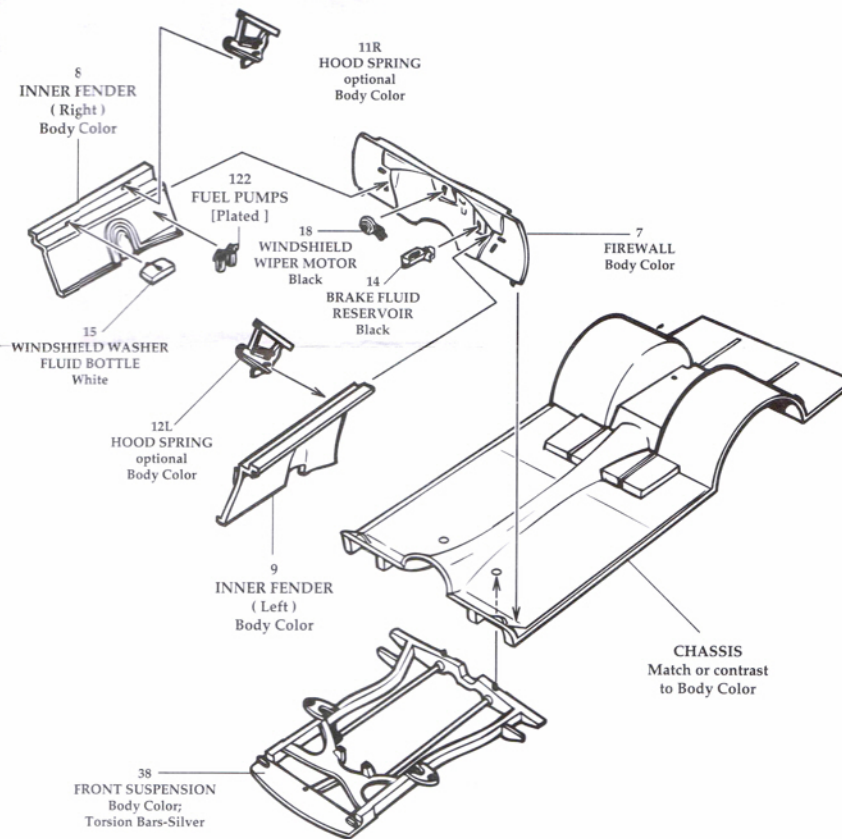

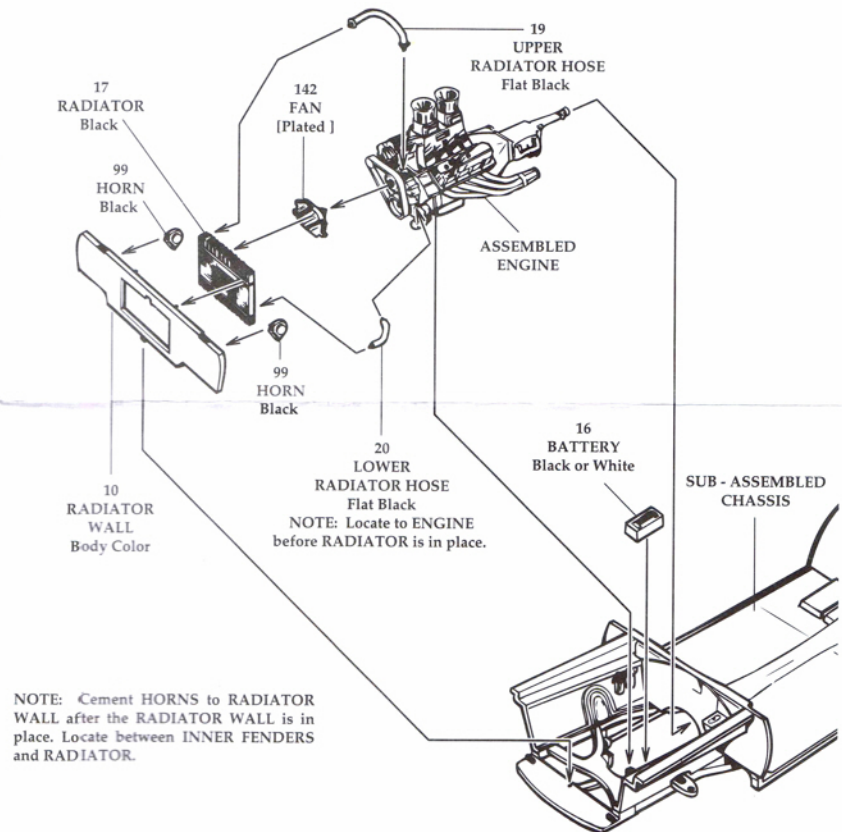

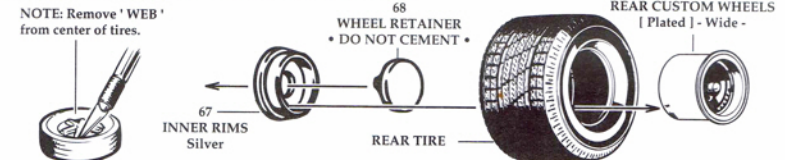
